Thank you for supporting our students to wear face masks as we transition into post-lockdown this week.

The WA Government have announced the post-lockdown transition period will go until 12.01am on Saturday, 1 May.

During this time, secondary students and all teachers must wear masks. Teachers can remove masks to teach.
